BSDU's First Retreat





DAY ONE: DELIBERATING AND BRAINSTORMING WITH FREEDOM

To launch the Retreat, the President, Prof. Vivek Bhandari extended a hearty welcome to Mr. Jayant Joshi (Chief Functionary, RUJCT), Mr. Abhishek Joshi (Director, RUFIL), Mr. Markus Gmeiner (CEO, JCF, Switzerland), and all the participants to the event. In addition, describing the main objectives of the two-day event, the President discussed the usefulness of Open Space Technology and how it is different from an overly-structured system; and provides a platform where the participants are encouraged to think out of the box and come up with new ideas.





The President also spoke of how the use of this tool succeeds in strengthening the bond among the participants, their commitment towards BSDU, and developing ideas for future planning. In his closing remarks, he underlined the centrality of two main principles of OST in the Retreat:

- 1. Equality: All the employees working in the university are equally important and play crucial roles for the university's smooth functioning and growth. Every vertical is equally important.
- 2. Intellectual Honesty: All participants in the university are expected to be honest and sincere in their discussions about how to work towards fulfilling the vision and mission of the university.

Mr. Jayant Joshi (Chief Functionary, RUJCT), in his address lauded the President, Prof. Vivek Bhandari's initiative in hosting the event where the entire staff gathered to discuss and plan for the future development of the university. The memory of the Late Dr. Rajendra Kumar

Joshi brought forth feelings of nostalgia. He stated that BSDU is the outcome of the hard work, devotion, and perseverance of the Late Dr. Rajendra Kumar Joshi and his wife, Ms. Ursula Joshi, who had a vision for skill education in India and intended to develop an environment comparable to the Swiss Dual System in Switzerland.





Mr. Abhishek Joshi (Director, RUFIL) congratulated the President and the team on organizing the event. He described the Late Dr. Rajendra Kumar Joshi's ambitions, his opinions concerning society and the system, and the necessity to bring skill education to India. Mr. Abhishek Joshi, too, grew sentimental. He mentioned that the founder chairman intended to adapt the education system to the current needs and improve the lives of people via skill education. He identified the gap and accepted.

The challenge of establishing a model skill university. Mr. Abhishek Joshi was glad to share that several employees of BSDU had played a crucial role in fulfilling the vision of Dr. Rajendra Kumar Joshi to skill India's Youth. Mr. Abhishek Joshi also mentioned that the university is still in the planning stages, and everyone involved needs to connect and bridge the gap between the Swiss Dual System and the Indian ground realities.

There were several ice-breaking activities to let people get to know one another better, and to lighten the mood. The activities were conducted creatively by Ms. Rashmi Chaudhary, Head/Manager-HR.

The Ice Breaking sessions were followed by lunch, after which the participants broke-up into nine groups (with 4-5 members in each group) and made posters addressing the personal (intellectual and emotional) connection with the mission of BSDU, the optimal teaching-learning process that would allow for the integration of the Swiss Dual education system into the Indian educational landscape, and their expectations as professionals and members of the BSDU community.

The teams worked together and made nine posters which were presented in three rounds. The emphasis of their work was mainly on three broad domains: refocusing, reshaping, and redefining the university's priorities for growth. The posters captured the views of each team's perspectives, thoughts, techniques, and expectations for the growth of the university. As the afternoon progressed, the teams presented their posters, and invited questions and

discussions from those present.



Participants were encouraged to stick notes and feedback on the posters. Everyone was invited to experience freedom, share their thoughts on the posters, and take responsibility for them in order to support true empowerment. Each participant made an effort to comprehend the various strategies utilized by each group, and they commented on the posters in accordance with the information that they had gleaned. The President lauded the collaborative effort that was put forward.

The first day of the event ended with various sports activities and games like cricket, badminton, volleyball, tug of war and spoon race.

DAY TWO: CONSOLIDATING AND INITIATING THE STRATEGIC PLANNING PROCESS





The second day began with a revitalizing session on "Heartfulness" meditation led by Dr. Sandeep Kumar Tomar, Registrar, BSDU where he taught the participants to practice a heart-centered approach towards life. He also showed how such a practice can improve the quality of life, and eventually the quality of work.

The President, Prof. Vivek Bhandari provided an overview of the events conducted on the first day of the Retreat. He discussed the key challenges that employees face, such as striving for high quality, wanting others to learn, and achieving high educational quality. He also discussed the need for BSDU to nurture links with industry, students, and government of the kind comparable to those maintained in Switzerland.





Mr. Markus Gmeiner (CEO, JCF, Switzerland) was delighted with the previous day's discussions. While discussing the formation of BSDC/U, he became nostalgic. He added that Late Dr. Rajendra Kumar Joshi was inspired by the Swiss Dual System of Education and wished to provide job-oriented education to India's youth. With this mission in mind, BSDC came into existence as a training center in 2013 and started imparting training to students in the mechanical field. Following the success of BSDC, the Late Dr. Rajendra Kumar Joshi decided to launch additional skill programmes, which resulted in the establishment of BSDU in 2017. He desired to create a base-level workforce.

On the second day, utilizing the ideas from the first day as a springboard, as well as the remarks of Prof. Bhandari and Mr. Gmeiner, there was an open discussion about the strategic planning problems relating to the four objectives viz. developing an optimal design for a vocational education that balances India's ground realities and the Swiss Dual System moderated by Mr Chritian Reber; building curricula that meet the needs of our two primary stakeholders moderated by Prof. Binit Kumar Jha; ensuring the statutorily compliance in all matters moderated by Dr. Sandeep Kumar Tomar; and creating a campus culture which is nurturing for all members of the community moderated by Ms. Rashmi Chaudhary.

There was discussion about BSDU's past strengths and successes, as well as the current challenges. The team also concentrated on reforming areas and establishing an enabling environment and organizational culture at BSDU that are consistent with the organization's basic mission and vision.

The two-day event- **BSDU Retreat 2023** concluded with an expression of gratitude by the President, Prof. Vivek Bhandari. Participants jotted down their thoughts/comments on the poster that was made specifically for participants' feedback.




INTERNSHIP AND PLACEMENT
