IT Manager

Brief of Job Profile:

IT manager shall ensure that the hardware and software used by University is compatible, secure, and scalable. He/ She will also be responsible for managing our internal network and providing support for our staff. He/ she will also look for ways to grow our networks in a cost-effective manner to meet future needs.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- 1. Plan, execute, monitor and oversee the installation and maintenance of computer systems, hardware, and networks
- 2. Design, implement and maintain the organizations network infrastructure including WAN, LAN, wireless networks, EPABX system, Bio Metric System and CCTV System.
- 3. Develop and implement policies related to network security, disaster recovery, and IT infrastructure
- 4. Analyze resource utilization and develop strategies to optimize performance
- 5. Establish, measure, and define IT goals and maintain an IT roadmap
- 6. Monitor and analyze the success of IT initiatives and projects and continually develop and evaluate new technologies and tools for the BSDU
- 7. Direct the activities of the help desk to ensure the IT needs of users are met
- 8. Manage development projects to integrate new technologies into existing systems
- 9. Perform ongoing support and maintenance of all hardware, software, and network components
- 10. Establish a security policy to safeguard information by seeing that security risks are accurately identified, assessed, reported, and mitigated
- 11. Managing the IT infrastructure of both campuses of BSDU
- 12. Troubleshoot hardware and software issues related to internal IT
- 13. Managing the IT staff and keeping the executive team up to date on the latest networking technologies
- 14. Work closely with departmental heads/managers to determine the maintenance and growth needs of the network
- 15. Responsible for creating and administering disaster plans that will keep the company functional in the event of a crisis
- 16. Prepare and execute IT budget



Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Education: A bachelor's degree or Diploma in Computer Science, Information Technology or a related field.
- 2. Experience: At least five years of experience as IT Manager in University or in a large research organization.
- 3. IT Certifications such as CompTIA, CISCO, Microsoft and Linux
- 4. Language: English and Hindi are minimum essential requirements.

Key Competencies requirements:

- 1. Comprehensive understanding of network architecture and client/ server technology.
- 2. Strong problem solving and communication skills required.
- 3. Software development abilities preferred.
- 4. Strong troubleshooting and problem solving skills
